DGH USB-COMi INSTALLATION GUIDE

- 1. Insert the DGH Utility Software CD into the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Plug the USB-COMi into an empty USB port on the computer.
- 3. The following dialog screen should appear and select "Install from a list or specific location" as indicated in the picture below.
- 4. Select "Next" to continue.

- 5. At the next screen, select "Select the best driver in these locations".
- 6. Check the box "Select this location in the search".

- 1. Browse onto the DGH Utility Software CD-ROM.
- 2. Open the USB\DRIVERS\USB-COMi\ Folder.
- 3. Open the Operating System (O/S) folder that matches the O/S on your computer. For example, XP users should open the 2K-XP folder.
- 4. Double-click on the FTDIUNIN file to begin the un-install. This file is designated with an integrated circuit icon.
- 5. Once the un-installer begins, follow the prompts to remove the driver.
